Competitors will not pass technical inspection if they do not have a working MyLaps compatible

transponder. Failing to have an operational transponder during any session will result in a penalty.

Supply drop off procedure: 15 min deliveries during all open delivery hours (refer to Team Handbook)

All teams must use water barrels or concrete to tie down awnings and structures. Stakes cannot be used to tie down structures. Teams will be liable for any damage to the paddock from stakes or structures tied down inappropriately



Disposal and Recycling: Back center of paddock

Participants are required to make use of disposal locations for all waste materials. All spills must be treated immediately and track management must be advised. All fuel containers, and tires must be removed from the facility.



Golf Carts Contact: Refer to team/crew packet

Circuit Rules: Operators must be over 18. Speed limit is 10 mph.

Pit support vehicles must be parked within the team's paddock footprint or at the designated parking area and must display a 2019 MotoAmerica Pit Vehicle Pass.
