MotoAmerica Mini Cup Single Event Entry Fee per rider - \$175


Obligations

- All credential holders require an AMA membership (or youth membership)
- Entry fee based on event list below
- All bikes must have a transponder you must provide your own transponder
- MotoAmerica's fuel supplier is VP and it is preferred that this brand be used. VP MGP fuel must be used. No branding, decals or signage or fuel brands other than VP will be allowed.
- Provide a professional and clean appearance

Benefits

- Includes one P1 parking pass and space for a 10'X10' EZ up
- Prize package per class
 - **↓ 110 Season Champion:** Wins a sponsored ride for 2021 MotoAmerica Mini Cup in the next class up. This means the rider will be loaned a GP-0 160 for the 2021 season and Rise Moto will cover their entry fees for 2021 (up to \$1000). It does not include tires/maintenance/travel or any other costs. Rider also gets wildcard spot at Ohvale World Cup in October (usage of bike is free but costs are not covered)
 - **110 Season Runner-Up:** 2021 MotoAmerica Mini Cup entry fees covered by Rise Moto (up to \$1000). Rider also gets wildcard spot at Ohvale World Cup in October (usage of bike is free but costs are not covered)
