



Motoamerica Mini Cup Competitor Bulletin 01-2020 Road America Information

General Information

- Competitors are limited to one 10x10 canopy for their “hot pit” area which will be nearest the kart track. If you park your vehicle behind your awning you will most likely be stuck there and unable to get out once everyone is set up on Friday. Please keep this in mind!
- There is **NO electric** in the “hot pit”. Competitors will need to bring a generator if they plan on using power for tire warmers or anything else.
- Rise Moto and Ohvale are aware that many competitors are still waiting on their orders of spare wheels for rain tires. Rest assured all wheels will be delivered either directly to the customer prior to the event or directly to Road America. This has been an unfortunate supply issue related to COVID-19 but they are working diligently on the solution.
- Track map with layout of track for MiniCup is posted for competitor use. Race direction is clockwise.
- Competitors are required to supply their own MyLaps/AMB transponder BUT in the event of an issue Road America does have some available for rent on a limited basis.
- Staging and entry for move-in will be at gate 4.
- Registration is required before participation. The registration office hours are Thursday 12:00 – 5:00 PM and Friday 7:00 AM – 5:00 PM. Registration located in the Registration building at Gate 6 at Road America.

Technical Information/Regulations/Inspection/Procedures

- Any competitors requiring their engine to be re-sealed at the event please contact bcretu@motoamerica immediately to confirm an appointment at the track on Friday afternoon.
- VP MGP is the spec fuel that competitors are required to use. It is **recommended** that competitors purchase some and ensure they have the correct jetting for this fuel prior to the event.
- All Ohvale motorcycles must have a brake lever guard (any brand is approved).
- All Ohvale motorcycles must have the RTGS kit for their specific motorcycle installed (or equivalent items). This kit includes a clutch cover guard, rain light, bellypan plugs (in event of rain), oversize overflow tank, and fuel tank foam. (sold by Rise Moto).
- All Ohvale motorcycles must have, at a minimum, the following items safety wired in order to pass technical inspection: **brake caliper bolts, oil drain, oil fill, oil filter cap bolts.**

Tire Service

- Dunlop has graciously offered to provide free tire service for competitors. This service will be offered on Friday afternoon, from 5PM-7PM, and Saturday afternoon, from 2PM-4PM, for MiniCup competitors (except in extraordinary circumstances).
- Races run **rain or shine!** There will be no time for competitors to completely swap rain tires onto their wheels. It is recommended that competitors have spare wheels with rain tires already mounted in the event of inclement weather (see note above regarding spare wheels).
- Rise Moto will have some supply of tires at the event for purchase but it is recommend to order in advance and come prepared.
