All flags except standing Yellow are waved

	Flag	Meaning
	<u>Standing</u> <u>Yellow</u>	There is an incident or hazard, off track in the next section.
	Waved	Use Caution. No overtaking until the green flag. There is an incident or hazard on the track in the next section.
	Yellow	Use Caution. Be prepared to stop. No overtaking until the green flag.
	Wayad	At the start of practice, sighting laps and warm up laps - the track is clear .
	<u>Waved</u> <u>Green</u>	
		After an incident – you may now overtake.
	<u>Waved</u> Surface	Use Caution.
×		Something like debris or oil (but not rain) is reducing the grip of the track in the next section.
Á	<u>Waved</u> <u>Rain</u>	Be aware that it is starting to rain. Race control knows about it.
	<u>Surface and</u> rain waved	Use Caution.
Y/T	together	The rain is starting to reduce the grip of the track.
	Waved Red	The session has been stopped, possibly due to an incident.
		Return to the pits with caution and watch out for an incident on the way back.
	<u>Waved</u> <u>Meatball &</u>	If your number is on the board, then there is an urgent safety problem with you or your bike.
	<u>number</u> <u>board</u>	Get off the track, as soon as you safely can.
93		Don't wait to finish the lap, pull off right away.
	<u>Waved Black</u> <u>& number</u>	If your number is on the board, then there is a problem with you or your bike.
46	<u>board</u>	Pull into the pits on the next lap.
P	White flag	You are starting the last lap of the race.
	<u>Checkered</u> <u>Flag</u>	The practice session, or the race, is over.
