	Yellow	
		Use Caution. No overtaking until the green flag.
	Waved	There is an incident or hazard on the track in the next section.
	<u>Yellow</u>	
		Use Caution. Be prepared to stop. No overtaking until the green flag.
	<u>Waved</u>	At the start of practice, sighting laps and warm up laps - the track is clear.
	<u>Green</u>	
		After an incident – you may now overtake.
	Waved	Use Caution.
	<u>Surface</u>	
		Something like debris or oil (but not rain) is reducing the grip of the track in the next section.
