Teams and crew

We can only allow 5 crewmembers plus a rider. Names must be listed on the entry form. Each person will need to complete the MotoAmerica electronic waiver. Use of a cell phone is required. Click here to request the waiver to be sent to your phone: <u>MotoAmerica Speedwaiver</u>. Please have a team representative also complete the Entrant Health survey listing rider and crew names. <u>Entrant Health</u> <u>Survey</u>

Media credentials

If you are bringing someone that will be filming or taking pictures for media, they will be required to have a media pass you can apply for this by emailing the request form to <u>dkingham@motoamerica.com</u> – please include a face shot phot : <u>Media Request Form</u>

The media credential will not count toward your total crew count.

Technical Inspection

Mobile technical inspection will be provided in the Bagger's paddock area at 4:00 pm Thursday, following Move In.

Transponders

Bring your own if possible. We understand that some people will not have access to a transponder, so we are currently working with another race organization to make transponders available for rent at Laguna. I will update everyone a soon as the specifics are nailed down. See the last page of the Baggers rules for more information on the transponders.

Fuel Supply

You may use any type of VP fuel but the only fuel that can be pre-ordered and supplied at the track is VP T4. Preorder Fuel here (request by 10/11/20 as late or omitted orders may have a late fee) : <u>VP Fuel</u> <u>Request</u>

Dunlop Tires

Dunlop Tires is offering one free set of tires (available only at the Dunlop truck at the event at Laguna Seca) to the Bagger entries in exchange for compliance with the following actions:

- Dunlop decals in visible areas such as fork legs, and saddlebags (we can supply the stickers)
- Yellow tire stickers on both front and rear race tires
- Agree to podium hat protocol of wearing a Dunlop hat by riders

Dunlop will provide each of the 14 teams one set of Q4 17" front and rear tires at the event. Also provided will be standard tire mounting and balancing service for these tires as well as any other tires they have brought on their own.
