

2020 COVID-19 Pit Lane & Race Starts Procedure

- Only Teams actively participating in the current session are allowed on Hot Pit Lane.
- Access gates onto and off of Hot Pit Lane will be restricted and labeled accordingly. Any 2-way gates will be labeled to allow 6' between entry and exit.
- Bikes will have to be launched from The Paddock. At the end of each session, machines will be directed either up into the Paddock or Parc Formé (schedule dependent).
- Spacing of Pit Stalls will be implemented by the Pit Stall assignments. Individual Teams participating in the same session will not be allowed to occupy adjacent Pit Stalls. Pit Stalls will be assigned alternately based on Class.
- Team members of different teams must maintain 6' physical distancing on the signaling wall. Signal wall will be marked with 6' spacing. Only <u>ONE</u> team member per bike is allowed on the Signal Wall at a time.
- ALL races will use the Quick Start Procedure outlined below. Please familiarize yourself with this procedure and plan accordingly. Countdown to the opening of Pit Exit for the Sighting lap will ONLY be announced via Team Radio channel. With only 60 seconds to exit Pit Lane for the Sighting Lap, RADIOS ARE CRITICAL!!!
- Based on your location in the Paddock, it can be a VERY long distance to the Grid. Please begin early creating a plan to both launch the bike from the Paddock and get 1 mechanic to the Grid for the Race Start.
- There will be no volunteer Row Marshals. Depending on the sizes of the fields, we may be limited to having a Row Marshal (MotoAmerica Staff Member) at every OTHER row (ie. Rows 1.3.5....). We will notify teams via Team Radio prior to the affected Race Starts.

QUICK START PROCEDURE

Sighting Lap- Pit Lane Exit Open for 60 seconds. DON'T get caught on Pit Lane!!

Riders take one lap at unrestricted speed

Riders arriving behind Safety car must enter pit lane, start warm-up lap from pit lane and start race from the **back** of the Grid.

Riders arrive on grid

One Mechanic on grid to indicate position to rider

 ${\bf NO}$ tools. ${\bf NO}$ stand. ${\bf NO}$ warmers. ${\bf NO}$ generator.

Bike set = Mechanics exit immediately

Warm-up lap (30 Second Board)

30-second Board & Horn- front of grid

GREEN FLAG Waved at front of Grid to start warm-up lap

Riders on Pit Lane join Warm-up after field has passed/ must start race from back of grid

Steward with Red flag at Front of grid

Riders arrive at grid position

Race Start

Front wheel up to or behind front line in grid box- CONTACT PATCH OF TIRE MUST BE IN BOX

Number panels removed to indicate row is complete - panels not removed if rider in that row has an issue. Remember to go TALL and SMALL if you have an issue.

Steward with red flag at front of grid proceeds to exit

Machines in gear

Red light is turned on (2-5 seconds)

No movement

Red light goes off to start race
