



2021 MotoAmerica – King of The Baggers ECU-Requirements

- A Baggers race ECU must be nominated and sent for approval by the ECU manufacturer no later than March 15th, 2021 and be made available to the public worldwide by March 30, 2021 through all approved dealers. For 2022 the approval date will be January 31st, 2022.
- 2. For the race ECU to be approved the retail price including software, any activations and upgrades or necessary hardware (e.g. ignition driver, connection cables, and lambda modules) must be less than:
 - a) \$1300 if the ECU excludes data logging

The ECU (with software and activations) and additional required parts must be individually priced and available separately.

- 3. The manufacturers are allowed to offer service contracts when the team is using the approved and listed electronics products. The electronics manufacturers cannot demand a service contract for a customer or participant in order to obtain any product.
- 4. Electronics manufacturers must supply MotoAmerica with documentation that details all of the components that will be offered. Details must include:
 - a. Price of each part.
 - b. List of all part numbers associated.
 - c. Any communication tools or software.
 - d. Price and availability of parts (with lead time).
 - e. List of all Firmware versions. Any new firmware versions must be approved my Technical director
- 5. The information must arrive at MotoAmerica by January 31 of the season in order that the last approved list can be made available to the teams no later than the February 15 of the racing seasons.
- 6. Final approval is upon discretion of MotoAmerica Technical Director.

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
