Wet Sighting Laps

Due to the unique pit exit at NJMP, Race direction has modified the wet sighting laps procedure. Assuming no wet warm up session, if the race is declared wet Race Direction will institute a 7 minute wet session where riders will be allowed to go through the front straight. The session will be checkered and simultaneously a 7 minute call made for pit lane opening for a quick start. An example is below:

Superbike Wet Sighting Lap session 1:50- 1:57

Pit Lane opens for Sighting lap 2:05

Pit Lane closes for the Sighting Lap 2:06

30 sec board and horn 2:07:30

Green flag waved, start of the warm up lap 2:08

Red light out 2:10

If it starts raining during the start procedure or during the race, the start delayed board or red flag will be displayed, all riders will return to the pit lane, and timing given via teams radio for the wet sighting lap session following a similar procedure as above.
