

2023 SUPERBIKE CUP ENTRY OPTIONS

The Superbike Cup Scholarship Program proposed program allows riders with a Superbike Cup license to compete in both in the Stock 1000 and Superbike classes. Additionally, MotoAmerica and the AMA proposes license changes which allow riders who would have been ineligible to maintain eligibility for Stock 1000 while transitioning to the Superbike class. Riders who are issued the Superbike Cup license submit an entry in the Stock 1000 class and if the rider earns a time in a qualifying session in Stock 1000 qualifying that also qualifies for the Superbike class for that event then the rider will also be added to the Superbike class races for that event. MotoAmerica Stock 1000 Single Event Entry Fee - \$350.00 per rider Benefits

- Eligible to compete in the Superbike class races if earn a qualifying time for Superbike at that event in the Stock 1000 qualifying session—at no additional cost. (for non Stock 1000 events rider must pay the Superbike entry fee)
- Includes one (1) season parking pass and one (1) season pit vehicle pass
- Paddock footprint 30' x 25' space for working trailer including awning (no cars/trucks allowed in the paddock footprint)
- Eligible for both class purse distribution as follows:

Stock 1000 class

- o Position 1 \$1000
- o Position 2 \$750
- o Position 3 \$500
- o Position 4 \$350
- o Position 5-10 \$200
- o Position 11-15 \$150

Superbike class

Purse distribution as follows (TBD):

- o Top Non-Premier riders through result position 20 \$750 per race
- Eligible for the Superbike Scholarship Cup, where the top three riders participating in the entire season receive a season ending purse of \$25,000, \$10,000, \$5,000. To be eligible for season ending purse rider must have participated in both superbike races for a minimum of four (4) total events.
- Free set of tires for the top five participating Stock 1000 riders in each race, based on Superbike race finishes.

Additional credential fees

- Season working credential \$750 per person (AMA membership required)
- Single event working wristband -early \$100 per person per event (AMA membership required)
- Single event working wristband -late \$125 per person per event (AMA membership required)
- Single event paddock wristband- \$60 per person per event over age 12

Entry Upgrade Options:

Season entry registration offers the rider automatic entry into each applicable event without worries of watching for entry deadlines throughout the season. These options also include additional benefits. See the options listed below for details.





2023 SUPERBIKE CUP ENTRY OPTIONS

MotoAmerica Stock 1000 Season Entry Fee - \$3250 per rider

Benefits

- Guaranteed entry in Stock 1000 class for each round (5 rounds)
- Eligible to compete in the Superbike class races if earn a qualifying time for Superbike at that event at no additional cost (for non Stock 1000 events rider must pay the Superbike entry fee as a separate entry)
- Priority paddock footprint
 - 50' x 25' space for working trailer including awning (no cars/trucks allowed in the paddock footprint)
- 2 season working credentials and parking passes
- 20 Single Event Paddock Wristbands per season
- 1 pit vehicle pass
- Eligible for both class purse distribution as follows:

Stock 1000 class

Position 1 - \$1000
Position 2 - \$750
Position 5-10 - \$200
Position 3 - \$500
Position 11-15 - \$150

Superbike class

Purse distribution as follows (TBD):

- o Top Non-Premier riders through result position 20 \$750 per race
- Eligible for the Superbike Scholarship Cup, where the top three riders participating in the entire season receive a season ending purse of \$25,000, \$10,000, \$5,000. To be eligible for season ending purse rider must have participated in both superbike races for a minimum of four (4) total events.
- Free set of tires for the top five participating Stock 1000 riders in each race, based on Superbike race finishes.

Obligations

- Provide one rider per round (Subject to fine without notification)
- Contact Registration manager on rider cancellation/rider substitution REQUIRED
- Notify Race Control if you will not compete in Superbike class for both races at any event
- Provide a professional and clean appearance
- Working credential holders require an AMA membership and minimum age 16 (minor waiver required)

Additional credential fees

- Season working credential \$750 per person (AMA membership required)
- Single event working wristband -early \$100 per person per event (AMA membership required)
- Single event working wristband -late \$125 per person per event (AMA membership required)
- Single event paddock wristband- \$60 per person per event over age 12
