Entries and rider licenses will not be processed at the track. All riders must have a valid 2023 AMA license

Teams must have one crew member monitoring this "listen only" channel during all on track events. Radios must be presented during tech inspection.

No fuel cans can remain on track property, teams failing to comply will be subject to a fine



Tech Location: Garage

Competitors will not pass technical inspection if they do not have a working MyLaps compatible transponder. Failing to have an operational transponder during any session will result in a penalty.



Garages: Non premier teams only

Supply drop off procedure: 15 min deliveries during all open delivery hours (refer to Team Handbook)

All teams must use water barrels or concrete to tie down awnings and structures. Stakes cannot be used to tie down structures. Teams will be liable for any damage to the paddock from stakes or structures tied down inappropriately



Disposal and Recycling: Back center of paddock

Participants are required to make use of disposal locations for all waste materials. All spills must be treated immediately and track management must be advised. All fuel containers, and tires must be removed from the facility.



Golf Carts Contact: Refer to team/crew packet

Circuit Rules: Operators must be over 18. Speed limit is 10 mph.

Pit support vehicles must be parked within the team's paddock footprint or at the designated parking area and must display a 2023 MotoAmerica Pit Vehicle Pass.

Coaxial Locations:

Do not distribute the log in information to fans or guests as increased users may cause the system to slow or stop functioning. Teams must provide their own hardware to connect to the timing and scoring feed over coax or network cable
