Entries, credentials and rider licenses will not be processed at the track. All riders must have a valid 2023 AMA license. All credential requests must be received by this deadline. No post entry credentials allowed. All persons must execute online waiver.

Teams must have one crew member monitoring this "listen only" channel during all on track events. Radios must be presented during tech inspection.



Tech Location: Tech Center

Competitors will not pass technical inspection if they do not have a working MyLaps compatible transponder. The transponder used to pass technical inspection must be the transponder used throughout the weekend. Failing to notify MotoAmerica staff of a transponder change may result in loss of lap times while using the unapproved transponder

Hot Pit Assignments: Released at event

Supply drop off procedure: 15 min deliveries during all open delivery hours (refer to team handbook)

RV Parking: Cost TBD, contact paddock@motoamerica.com

All teams must supply water barrels or concrete to tie down awnings and structures, no stakes may be used to tie down structures. Teams will be liable to damage to the paddock from stakes or structures tied down inappropriately



Disposal and Recycling: Back center of paddock in safety clean containers

Participants are required to make use of disposal locations for all waste materials. All spills must be treated immediately and track management must be advised of all spills. All fuel containers, and tires must be removed from the facility.
