Hot Pit Assignments: Temporary during sessions only. Supply drop off procedure: 15 min deliveries during all open delivery hours (refer to teams book)

All teams must supply water barrels or concrete to tie down awnings and structures, no stakes may be used to tie down structures. Teams will be liable to damage to the paddock from stakes or structures tied down inappropriately



Disposal and Recycling: yellow containers *Participants are required to make use of disposal locations for all waste materials. All spills must be treated immediately and track management must be

advised of all spills. All fuel containers, and tires must be removed from the facility. Teams found not complying with this policy may be fined*
