Tech Location: Tech Center

Competitors will not pass technical inspection if they do not have a working MyLaps compatible transponder. The transponder used to pass technical inspection must be the transponder used throughout the weekend. Failing to notify MotoAmerica staff of a transponder change may result in loss of lap times while using the unapproved transponder

All teams must supply water barrels or concrete to tie down awnings and structures, no stakes may be used to tie down structures. Teams will be liable to damage to the paddock from stakes or structures tied down inappropriately



Disposal and Recycling: Back center of paddock in safety clean containers

Participants are required to make use of disposal locations for all waste materials. All spills must be treated immediately and track management must be advised of all spills. All fuel containers, and tires must be removed from the facility.
