



## 2026 SUPERBIKE ENTRY OPTIONS

---

### MotoAmerica Superbike Single Event Entry Fee - \$400.00 per rider

#### Benefits

- Paddock footprint – 25' x 30' space for working trailer including awning (no cars/trucks allowed in the paddock footprint)
- Purse distribution as follows: (funds distributed by paper check by mail)
  - o 1<sup>st</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$2000 per race
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$1500
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$1250
  - o 4<sup>th</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$1000
  - o 5<sup>th</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$950
  - o 6<sup>th</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$750
  - o 7<sup>th</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$750

#### Obligations

- All bikes must have a transponder – you must provide your own transponder
- All bikes must be equipped with a Race Link device – you must provide your own device
- Provide a professional and clean appearance
- All hotpit credential holders require an AMA membership and minimum age 16 (minor waiver required)

#### Additional credential fees

- Season working credential - \$750 per person (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event working pass -early - \$125 per person per event (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event working pass -late - \$150 per person per event (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event paddock pass- \$75 per person per event over age 12
- Pit Vehicle pass - \$50 each (season sticker)

\*parking passes included with all credentials – working passes – P1 parking / paddock wristbands – general parking

### Entry Upgrade Options:

Season entry registration offers the rider automatic entry into each applicable event without worries of watching for entry deadlines throughout the season. These options also include additional benefits.

### MotoAmerica Superbike Season Entry Fee - \$8000 per rider

(season entry fee increases by 10% starting February 1<sup>st</sup>)

#### Benefits

- Includes one (1) season parking pass and one (1) season pit vehicle pass
- Guaranteed entry for each round
- Priority Paddock footprint including hospitality (hospitality optional)
- 100' x 30' space for working trailer including awning (no cars/trucks allowed in the paddock footprint)
- 4 Season Working Credentials and parking passes
  - Additional Season credentials available for purchase.
  - Additional single event working pass available for purchase.
- 20 Single Event Paddock pass per season
  - Additional single event paddock passes available for purchase.
- 1 pit vehicle pass
- 10'X10' reserved space on pit lane (subject to availability)
- Purse distribution as follows: (funds distributed by paper check by mail)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$2000 per race
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$1500
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$1250
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$1000
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Non-Premier rider - \$950

#### Obligations

- **Provide one rider per round (subject to penalty)**
- **Contact Registration manager on rider cancellation/rider substitution – REQUIRED**
- All bikes must have a transponder – you must provide your own transponder
- All bikes must be equipped with a Race Link device – you must provide your own device
- Provide a professional and clean appearance
- All credential holders require an AMA membership and minimum age 16 (minor waiver required)
- Machine to be equipped with rules conforming exhaust with a dBA rating 115 (if not compliant a reduction of \$250 per race will be applied to purse distribution)
- Entry fee balance due by April 1st

#### Additional credential fees

- Season working credential - \$750 per person (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event working pass -early - \$125 per person per event (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event working pass -late - \$150 per person per event (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event paddock pass- \$75 per person per event over age 12

\*parking passes included with all credentials – working passes – P1 parking / paddock wristbands – general parking

## 2026 SUPERBIKE ENTRY OPTIONS

### MotoAmerica Superbike Premier Entry Fee - \$9000 per rider

**\*Premier entry registration is by application only and not a guarantee.** Upon reviewing your application, MotoAmerica has the right to deny or approve your request. Premier rider entries are selected on a limited basis and approval is based on certain criteria including presentation, rider results, quantity of riders on the team, bike manufacturer.

Interested parties should express interest by October 24, 2025.

#### Benefits

- Includes one (1) season parking pass and one (1) season pit vehicle pass
- Guaranteed purse of \$3,500 per race, \$70,000 per season per rider (subject to event participation)
- Priority paddock footprint including hospitality (maximum size)
- 100' x 30' space for working trailer including awning (no cars/trucks allowed in the paddock footprint)
- 8 Season Working Credentials and parking passes (additional available for purchase)
- 20 Single Event Working pass per season. (additional available for purchase)
- 1 promotional model pass per rider per event
- 20 VIP Guest Hotpit Credentials
- 63 Single Event Paddock **passes** per season (additional available for purchase)
- 2 pit vehicle passes
- Mobile technical inspection
- Agreed moving images from on-board camera (to be used for digital purposes)
- Sponsor access to discounted media group partner advertising (subject to availability)
- 10'X15' reserved space on pit lane
- \*parking passes included with all credentials – working passes – P1 parking / VIP Hotpit Credential – P1 parking /paddock wristbands – general parking

#### Obligations

- **Provide one rider per round (subject to penalty)**
- **Contact Registration manager on rider cancellation/rider substitution - REQUIRED**
- Provide hospitality for team staff/team sponsors/team guests
- All bikes must have a transponder – you must provide your own transponder
- All bikes must be equipped with a Race Link device – you must provide your own device
- Provide a professional and clean appearance
- Accessibility to team rider(s) and staff for promotional activities during event
- Accessibility to team rider(s) and staff for promotional activities outside event
- All working credential holders require an AMA membership and minimum age 16 (minor waiver required)
- Rider/Team participation in MotoAmerica Social Media Policy
- Rider/Team participation in MotoAmerica Premier Entrant Video Policy and provide agreed rider/team videos
- Machine to be equipped with rules conforming exhaust dBA rating 115 (if not compliant a reduction of \$250 per race will be applied to purse distribution)
- Entry fee balance due by April 1<sup>st</sup>

#### Additional credential fees

- Season working credential - \$750 per person (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event working pass -early - \$125 per person per event (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event working pass -late - \$150 per person per event (age 18/AMA membership required)
- Single event paddock pass- \$75 per person per event over age 12
