

## **MOTOAMERICA COMPETITOR BULLETIN**

The American Motorcyclist Association and MotoAmerica have edited the 2017 Regulations to provide more specificity regarding the post session technical control procedures. The regulations have been edited as follows:

2.11.12 At the end of Superpole, qualifying, races, or qualifying practice, all classified motorcycles must be placed immediately, with no delay in the parc ferme for a period of at least 30 minutes after the end of the session: unless held longer at the discretion of the technical director. During this period, after the end of the session, no work may be performed, including downloading of data, unless at the express request of the Technical Director. Competitors must retrieve their motorcycles within approximately 30 minutes after the motorcycle entered the parc ferme, except for those motorcycles chosen for disassembly. After this time limit, the parc ferme officials will no longer be responsible for the motorcycles left behind.
