The American Motorcyclist Association and MotoAmerica have edited the 2017 Regulations due to increasing performance of the Supersport spec tire, and to move them in line with the Superbike/Superstock 1000 qualification standards. The regulations have been edited as follows to REMOVE the requirement for 110% of the fastest Supersport rider, and alter the LCQ 110% requirement.

- 1.18.7.3.1 To qualify for the Supersport/Superstock 600 Race, a Superstock 600 rider must achieve a time at least equal to 107% of the time recorded by the fastest Superstock 600 rider or be ranked in the top 15 Superstock 600 riders of the 600 combined (Group 1 and 2) qualifying sessions.
- 2. For double header rounds, all riders will be automatically qualified for both races, as long as they meet the provisions above.
- 3. The top 5 from the Superstock 600 Last Chance Qualifier will be qualified for the Supersport / Superstock 600 Race for that day, as long as they achieve a time at least equal to 110% of the time recorded by the fastest rider of the 600 combined (Group 1 and 2) qualifying sessions or 107% of the fastest Superstock 600 rider, whichever is slower.
