MotoAmerica is reminding all competitors of a few regulations. Effective immediately all competitors have received an official warning for the following violations, any subsequent violations will result in penalties.

1. Removing your hands from the handlebars for the purposes of aiding aerodynamics is in violation of section 1.21, behavior during practice or race.
2. Brake caliper bolts and oil drain plug bolts must be wired, according to 2.3.3 and .10.7 BRAKES section of each class.
3. Tire warmers must be removed by the 3 minute board, according to 1.22.1.h.
4. Teams must be in possession of a team radio, those not in possession may be subject to fines. All teams must present their radio in tech.
5. At all times riders must have a functioning transponder. Riders not in possession of a functioning transponder will be black flagged and removed from practice or qualifying sessions. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure the transponder is mounted and functioning. We will make best efforts to score malfunctioning transponders in races and Superpole. Teams who habitually have transponder malfunctions in races may be subject to penalty.
